**T**his organic, free-form house rises in front of the Pacific Ocean in Playa Cibola de Mar, near Ensenada, Baja California. The free-shaped windows expose a particular view, allowing the light to come in. Some were crafted in stained glass by the Bitterlin's.

The master bedroom has a round bed, 3/4 bath and twin beds on the upper level mezzanine. The house includes an unusual, fully equipped kitchen, a dining room, a comfortable living room, 1/2 bath and a queen bedroom on the ground level. It is a romantic getaway for two, or a unique family vacation for up to six.

Each corner of the villa is particularly decorated with crafts from all over Mexico, carefully chosen for each spot in the house, as well as custom-made furniture, antiques and folk art accompanied by wild flowers and native growth enhance and complete the setting.
